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## Change Notification UK National Blood Services No. 12 - 2021

### Immune Thrombocytopenia

This change applies to the Deceased Tissue Donor Selection Guidelines

Please amend the following sections of this entry:

<i>Obligatory:</i>	<p><b>Must not donate if:</b>  Associated with malignancy  <del>a) Symptomatic.</del>  <del>b) Chronic.</del>  <del>c) Recovered, but less than five 5 years from recovery.</del>  This applies to both adult and childhood disease.</p>
<i>Discretionary:</i>	<p>If underlying cause of thrombocytopenia is not a contraindication, accept. Refer to relevant DSG entry. Refer to designated clinical support officer if further advice required.</p>
<i>See if Relevant:</i>	<p><b>If treated with immunoglobulin:</b>  <a href="#">Immunoglobulin Therapy</a>  <a href="#">Transfusion</a>  <a href="#">Malignancy</a></p> <p><b>If treated with immunoglobulin or plasma exchange:</b>  <a href="#">Transfusion</a></p> <p><b>If treated with immunosuppressive therapy:</b>  <a href="#">Immunosuppression</a></p>
<i>Additional Information:</i>	<p>Immune thrombocytopenia can be associated with malignancies, especially haematological malignancies such as chronic lymphocytic leukaemia.</p>
<i>Reason for Change:</i>	<p><del>The links have been revised.</del>  <del>The phrase, 'Recovered, but has ever had a recurrence' has been removed as this was considered too restrictive.</del>  Amend the 'Obligatory' section, add 'Discretionary' and 'Additional Information' sections, add link to 'immunoglobulin therapy' and 'malignancy' entries.</p>

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
